After Your SYNVISC®/Synvisc-One® (hylan G-F 20) Injection

What to look for:

- Avoid activities that put excessive strain on your knee, such as jogging, lifting, or prolonged standing for 48 hours following the injection. Please consult your doctor regarding the appropriate time to resume such activities
- If you have any mild pain or swelling at the injection site, apply an ice pack on your knee as recommended by your doctor
- The most common side effects seen with the SYNVISC® family are pain, swelling, heat, redness, and fluid buildup around the knee. Please consult your doctor if you have concerns, if your symptoms do not go away, and/ or if you have other side effects

What to expect:

- Everyone responds differently, but many patients experienced osteoarthritis knee pain relief starting 1 month after their Synvisc-One injection¹, or as early as 1 week following the first injection with SYNVISC²
- SYNVISC/Synvisc-One can provide up to 6 months of osteoarthritis knee pain relief*1,2

Indication

SYNVISC® (hylan G-F 20) and Synvisc-One® (hylan G-F 20) are indicated for the treatment of pain in osteoarthritis (OA) of the knee in patients who have failed to respond adequately to conservative nonpharmacologic therapy and simple analgesics, e.g., acetaminophen.

Important Safety Information for Synvisc-One

SYNVISC and Synvisc-One are contraindicated in patients with known hypersensitivity to hyaluronan products or patients with infections in or around the target knee. Hypersensitivity reactions including anaphylactic reaction, anaphylactoid reaction, anaphylactic shock and angioedema have been reported for both SYNVISC and Synvisc-One.

Do not concomitantly use disinfectants containing quaternary ammonium salts for skin preparation because hyaluronan can precipitate in their presence. Do not inject SYNVISC or Synvisc-One extraarticularly, into the synovial tissues, into the fat pad or joint capsule, or intravascularly.

The safety and efficacy of Synvisc-One in locations other than the knee, or for conditions other than osteoarthritis, or in combination with other intra-articular injectables, or in severely inflamed knee joints have not been established. Use caution when injecting SYNVISC or Synvisc-One in patients allergic to avian proteins, feathers, or egg products; who have evidence of lymphatic or venous stasis in the leg to be treated; or who have severe inflammation in the knee to be treated. Remove any synovial fluid or effusion before injecting SYNVISC or Synvisc-One. Strict adherence to aseptic technique must be followed to avoid joint infection. The safety and effectiveness of SYNVISC and Synvisc-One have not been established in children (≤21 years old) or in pregnant or lactating women. Patients should be advised to avoid strenuous or prolonged weight-bearing activities for approximately 48 hours after treatment.after treatment with Synvisc-One.

For Synvisc-One

The most commonly reported adverse events were arthralgia, arthritis, arthropathy, injection site pain, and joint effusion. The following reported adverse events are among those that may occur in association with intraarticular injections, including Synvisc-One: arthralgia, joint stiffness, joint effusion, joint swelling, joint warmth, injection site pain, arthritis, arthropathy, and gait disturbance.
